By checking the truck tyre pressure regularly - for example every time the vehicle enters the company warehouse - companies and fleet managers can dramatically improve tyre life and the overall truck security.

The ATEQ VT TRUCK easily checks tyre pressure and sensor batteries to prevent under-inflation and reduce vehicle down-time due to tire blowouts (breakdowns). The

tool is compatible with most European truck and bus TPMS sensors and benefits from a constantly growing vehicle coverage, thanks to frequent database updates.

The VT TRUCK displays and stores up to 22 wheels of vehicle data and can read TPMS sensors in twin wheels. The tool reads and activates the TPMS sensors by selecting vehicle brand and model, by sensor or simply by scanning all known protocols.

The VT TRUCK is ideal for transport fleets, truck dealerships and multi-brand service workshops. It comes with 3 years of free software and database updates. The tool is available in Europe in September 2018 at a recommended sales price from 379 Euros.
